What's new on this CD?

- A total of 21 new tables have been added to this CD package. They include annual and monthly tables on hirings and separations, retirement age, labour force characteristics for rural and urban areas, wages of employees by job permanency and union coverage, weekly and hourly wage distributions and regional unemployment rates used by the Employment Insurance Program.
- With the addition of these new tables, we now have 2 CDs of Labour Force Survey data for the price of one. CD1 holds the most popular data tables, while CD2 holds data tables for more specialized labour market analysis.
- Also added to most tables are a few new age groups: ages 25 years and over, 55 to 64 and 65 years and over. And, all tables now have full titles and stubs no more abbreviations. Just click once on the title of the table in the Beyond 20/20 Table Browser and you will see the full title in the box below.
- Previous issues of the quarterly publication *Perspectives on Labour and Income* (from 1995 to 1999) are available in this package (under "LFS Documentation"), along with the recently released *Perspectives* article that reviews the year 2000 labour market.
