A few changes were made to the <u>CD1</u> and <u>CD2</u> tables this year.

- A new age group 45 to 64 years has been added to the monthly and annual table CD1T01 *Labour force estimates by detailed age groups and sex.*
- Table CD1T03an has been added *Labour force estimates of full- and part-time students during school months by age groups and sex.* This is an 8-month average (January to April and September to December) of the existing monthly table CD1T03mn.
- The monthly and annual tables for CD1T05 have been modified. The age group dimension has been added to this table and the NAICS two-digit industry groups now have estimates going back to 1976 (rather than 1987).
- Table CD1T54sa has been added. This table includes seasonally adjusted estimates of labour force, employment, unemployment and unemployment rates by major industry groups for Canada only.
- The monthly and annual tables of CD1T24 and CD1T25 which include estimates on hirings, separations, quits and layoffs by sex and age group and hirings by class of worker, industry and age group have been removed from <u>CD1</u>. A data quality problem has been detected in these series. Pending further investigation, the tables will not be available.
- The seasonally adjusted tables CD1T47 to CD1T54 have been revised going back three years (beginning with January 2000) based on the latest seasonal output. Also, all of the seasonally adjusted series have been reviewed for appropriateness, unique seasonal characteristics (such as moving or stable seasonality) and sampling errors associated with specific series that may change over time.
- The monthly and annual tables of CD1T13 and CD1T14 have been moved to CD2T15 and CD2T16 (to create more space on <u>CD1</u>).
- The CV calculator has been modified and now provides CVs for monthly employment estimates by industry and occupation of the three largest CMAs (Montréal, Toronto, Vancouver).
