## What's new on this CD?

- We now have 3 CDs of tables to accommodate the increasing size of the tables. CD3 now houses the wage data series.
- A new age group 15 to 64 years has been added to the monthly seasonally adjusted table CD1T47sa *Labour force estimates by age groups and sex*.
- To comply with Statistics Canada standards, the manufacturing durable and non-durable industry data has been modified, moving the NAICS code 3391-3399 from Non-durable to Durable. This change only affects the monthly and annual tables of CD1T05.
- We have also changed the NAICS industry group name (codes 55-56) from Management of companies, administrative and other support services to *Business, building and other support services*.
- The seasonally adjusted tables in CD1T47 to CD1T54 have been revised back three years (beginning with January 2001) based on the latest seasonal output. Also, all of the seasonally adjusted series have been reviewed for appropriateness, unique seasonal characteristics (such as moving or stable seasonality) and sampling errors associated with specific series that may change over time.
- For this year's version of the CV calculator, all CV estimates and models are based on the regression composite estimation. Because the models were not adequate, the following were removed: Economic regions of Laval, Laurentides, Côte-Nord et Nord-du-Québec, and Stanford-Bruce Peninsula. The industry *Finance, insurance and real estate and leasing* for CMA Toronto was also removed. Any other changes are mentioned in the **Introduction** of the CV calculator.
